



Silica Competency Training

Who Should Attend:

Foreman, Safety Personnel, Journeymen and Apprentices



Why:

OSHA has delayed enforcement of the New Silica Standard (§1926.1153 Respirable Crystalline Silica) until September 23, 2017. Regardless of your activities on the job site, a Silica Competent Person must be appointed by the employer *“who is capable of identifying existing and foreseeable respirable crystalline silica hazards in the workplace and who has authorization to take prompt corrective measures to eliminate or minimize them. The competent person must have the knowledge and ability necessary to fulfill the responsibilities set forth in paragraph (g) of this section”*. The employer will establish (g) *Written exposure control plan* and the competent person must be able to make sure it is adhered to. All employees must be trained in Silica Awareness.
